The mission of Palms Deaf Church is Experiencing and sharing the Love of God through American Sign Language. Rev. Lori Fuller has established this ministry with the ELCA, Florida Bahamas Synod and St. Mark by the Sea Lutheran Church in Palm Coast. There are almost a million deaf people in Florida alone and 95% of deaf people are unchurched. It is difficult for the signing population to feel in community in our congregations. Building community and sharing the love of Christ in the deaf population is an outreach that we can support.
