Holy Week Worship

Here are the worship opportunities during Holy Week (the times in bold will be live-streamed):

Maundy Thursday – 11 am and 7 pm

The word *maundy* comes from the same Latin word as *mandatum*, where we get the English words mandate and commandment. It comes from the reading in John's Gospel where we are given the new commandment: to love one another.

Good Friday – 11 am and 7 pm

This is the day we remember the crucifixion of our Lord. There are three main focuses for this service: The Passion account in John, Bidding Prayer and the adoration of the cross.

Easter Sunday – 9:30 am and 11 am

Early in the morning, women gather at the tomb to properly wash and care for Jesus' body, since it was hastily buried before the Sabbath. They wondered as they walked, "Who will roll away the stone for us?" When they got to the tomb, they found... well, you will just have to come to worship, or join us via live-stream, to hear the rest of the story!

Two Services on Easter

Both being mindful of those who are needing to find parking for the second service and choosing to worship in the Fellowship Hall are tangible ways we can be hospitable to others.

Parking

Trinity will provide two opportunities for worship on Easter Sunday, one at our regular time of 9:30 am and the second at 11:00 am. We are asking that those who attend the first service to be mindful of those coming to the later service. This means that we are encouraging those who attend the first service not to linger afterwards, but to exit the parking lot in a timely fashion to free up parking spots for those coming for the 11:00 am service.

Fellowship Hall

We will have additional seating in the Fellowship Hall, so that once the sanctuary is to capacity others can still participate in the service. We are asking some of our regular members to consider worshipping in the Fellowship Hall to free up spaces in the sanctuary for our visitors and guests.
