There are three expressions of our Church: congregations, synods, and the Churchwide organization. Congregations, like Trinity often have two annual meetings every year. Synods, like our Florida-Bahamas Synod, have an annual assembly. Every three years we gather voting members from all 65 synods and meet as a whole Church. That is happening next week, August 8-12 in Columbus, Ohio. Meeting under the theme "Embody the Word," the assembly will participate in plenary discussions to make decisions about the work of this church. They will also spend time in worship and Bible study.
