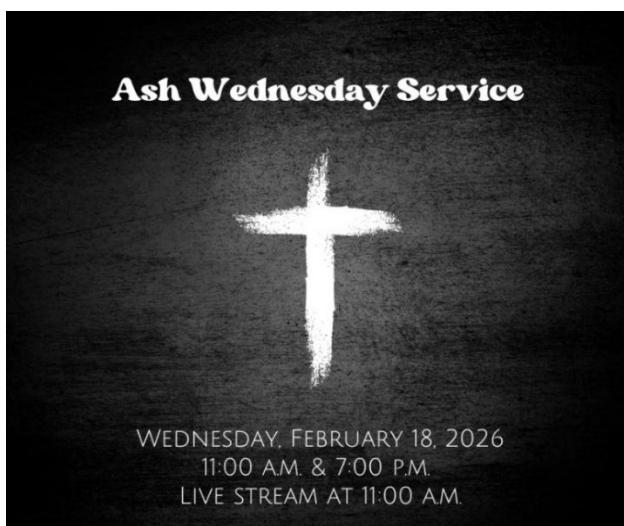
If you have interest in becoming a member at Trinity, please reach out to the church office. We are looking to have a new members class soon!
