Communion Procedures

Ushers will inform you when it is your turn to get up for communion. When prompted, your row will rise and walk to the front of the church. You will receive a wafer and then to you can move to your side to receive your juice/wine. Grape juice is in the innermost ring of the serving tray. Wine is in the two outermost rings of the serving tray. Communion cups can be disposed in the basket next to the juice/wine serving area. If you need communion brought to your pew, please inform the usher.
