God's Work Our Hands Sunday

The "God's work. Our hands." Sunday is scheduled for **September 7, 2025.** This day is an opportunity for the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA) to celebrate its mission of serving and loving neighbors.



Trinity is planning to help address food insecurity faced by many children within our local community. We will collect non-perishable food items for the month of August and on September 7th, we will come together after worship to assemble "weekend bags". These bags will be filled with the non-perishable food items and given to students to take home on Fridays. This ensures that they will have food to eat over the weekend when school is not in session. For those who have their yellow God's Work Our Hands t-shirts, you are encouraged to wear them on September 7th. For those who may not have one, feel free to wear yellow to celebrate the day!

Items being collected: individual cereal boxes, oatmeal, granola bars, pop tarts, individual shelf stable milk containers, Easy Mac (individual macaroni and cheese cups which are microwaveable), pop top canned foods such as ravioli, spaghetti and meatballs, beef-a-roni, etc., single serve canned chicken, single serve canned vegetables, individual pop-top cans of soup, single serve cans of tuna, single serve cans of Dinty Moore beef stew, snack bars, individual bags of dried fruits, individual fruit cups, individual pudding or Jello cups, individual bags of snack crackers. Treasurer Position Available


